Mr. Rowehl, Chairman, opened the meeting at 7:00 PM.

Mr. Rowehl introduced Ms. Carol Ogilvie of the Southwest Region Planning Commission.

Ms. Ogilvie gave a brief review of activity since the last meeting. She stated that the next step in the process would be to present the Master plan to the public for their input. Some information was missing from the Conservation Commissions report and Ms. Olgivie hoped to have it in time for the public meeting. Mr. Rowehl stated that he would also try to get some input from the Conservation Commission. Ms. Ogilvie will prepare a single page fact sheet for each chapter in the Master Plan, which would state the goals and objectives. Each sheet would have a map on one side and a synopsis on the other. Ms. Ogilvie felt that the Master Plan could be finalized following any input from the public meetings.

Ms. Ogilvie suggested that the best way to obtain public input would be to have both an evening meeting and a Saturday meeting. After some discussion it was agreed that public meetings would be held on Thursday April 27, 2000 and Saturday April 29, 2000. The secretary is to file the Notice of the Public Meeting no later than April 13, 2000.

Ms. Ogilvie will also prepare a press release for the Board, which hopefully would increase public attendance at the meetings. She also suggested that the Board consider serving refreshments at the Saturday meeting.

Ms. Olgivie left the meeting at 7:40 PM and the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM.
