

## EARTH EXCAVATION & RECLAMATION

### INSPECTION CHECKLIST

The following checklist is to be used by the Planning Board or it's agent to determine compliance with Antrim's regulation and the provisions of RSA 155-E during inspections of excavation sites , both for new operations as well as yearly inspections of existing operations. For existing, non permitted operations, only items #1 - 10 apply. New permitted operations are subject to all items. The items in the reclamation checklist apply to all operations at the time of reclamation.

### RECLAMATION STANDARDS

Antrim requirements per Section X of "Earth Excavation & Reclamation" regulation adopted 10/16/92

YES	NO	ITEM
_____	_____	A. All disturbed areas shall be spread with topsoil or any other soil capable of maintaining vegetation, and shall be planted with seedlings or grass suitable to prevent erosion
_____	_____	B. Areas visible from a public way, from which trees have been removed, shall be replanted with tree seedlings, set out in accordance with acceptable horticultural practices.
_____	_____	C. All earth and vegetative debris resulting from the excavation shall be removed or otherwise lawfully disposed of.
_____	_____	D. All slopes shall be graded to natural repose for the soil type. With no exception shall any slope be left steeper than 2:1. Changes of slope shall not be abrupt, but shall blend with the surrounding terrain.
_____	_____	E. Any standing bodies of water created by the excavation that is judged to constitute a hazard to health and safety shall be eliminated.
_____	_____	F. The topography of the land shall be left so that the water draining from the site leaves the property at the original, natural drainage points and in the natural proportions of flow.
_____	_____	G. For excavation projects requiring a permit from the Division of Water Supply and Pollution Control, the provisions of RSA 149:8-a shall supersede this regulation. Copies of all such permits shall be filed with the Planning Board
_____	_____	H. If deemed necessary by the Planning Board, suitable trees or shrubs shall be planted in order to provide screening and natural beauty and to aid in erosion control. Such planted areas shall be protected from erosion during an appropriate establishment period by adequate erosion control devices.
