

Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, August 21, 1989

Meeting called to order at 7:30

Minutes of last week to reflect corrections as follows. A call  
will be placed

to Alice Mae regarding the need to repair the fence at the  
Goodell Co. bridge.

The low bid was accepted for bins for recycling.

In the last paragraph, Madeleine had asked the Town Hall  
Committee not the Town study committee, to fill out a report for  
an energy audit.

Madeleine has since filled out the request for the energy audit  
and the building was checked today to see what aid the Town can  
receive for improvements.

Madeleine will write the Town Hall committee chairman, Harry Page  
and request he meet with the selectmen Sept. 11. A full report  
on the progress of the committee is to be submitted at that time.

Police Chief, Chris Joseph, has received a donation to be used  
toward a new program called DARE. Research is being done as to  
the best way to handle donations. If the money is sent to the  
Town for the program, authorization from the Town will be  
required to spend the funds. A tax exempt organization may have  
to be formed and all funds would then be deposited in an account  
set up just for DARE.

Phil Runyon's invoice was reviewed and approved for payment.

No problems have been found with the septic systems checked at  
Gregg Lake so far. Further tests will be postponed until more  
dye tablets are received.

Selectmen discussed the 1990 budget. It was agreed to request  
early budgets. Selectmen agreed to make an effort to hold the  
budget down as much as possible. A small percent increases to  
the department budgets will be allowed.

Payroll and yield tax warrant were signed.
