- **4.** Antrim 2020 Trail Group members to first tackle the Meadow Marsh Trail. Trail is in need of work and re-blazing. Temporary signs are being printed. Permanent signs are to be routed. Trail rehab is planned to be completed by National Trail Day ® on June 3, 2017. Stay tuned!!!!
- **5.** Road work on Brimstone Road. It seems the rogue road work has stopped again for the winter. Frank to keep on top of it.
- **6.** Selectmen to reinstate the Open Space Committee with 5 members and have discussed placing it under Con Com. 1 Selectman 1 con com member + general public. Peter to continue to work on potential members. Frank indicated some interest.
- 7. Warrant articles: terminating the open space \$\$\$\$ account ---to be used for Grove Street Bridge......
- 8. Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) is a non-native insect. EAB lacks predators to keep it in check. Infested trees die within 3 to 5 years. EAB only attacks ash trees, and is responsible for the death of millions of ash trees in the midwest. Help protect New Hampshire's ash trees. A <u>quarantine of all hardwood firewood, ash wood-products and all ash nursery stock is in effect for Belknap, Hillsborough, Merrimack and Rockingham Counties</u> More info may be found at <u>www.NHBUGS.org</u>
- **9.** Antrim Wind Warrant article draft and Conservation easement for Bean Property discussed. Following discussion Frank G moved that the ACC recommend that an independent agency/land trust not the town or the ACC take & monitor the Bean Easement in perpetuity. Ron C 2nd it. It was voted 3-0 in favor of motion (the chair does not vote, only when needed for a quorum or to break a tie). Also, Peter was directed to write a letter to the Selectmen and attend the Selectmen's meeting on January 30, 2017.
- 10. Wetland Permits- Permit by Notification was issued to Monadnock Paper for Forestry work.
