1. Draft July 2020 and September meeting notes were reviewed, amended and accepted.

## 2. Trails:

a. **Campbell Pond** – Jeremy DeLisle to place additional signs prohibiting motorized vehicles (OHRV- Off Highway Recreational Vehicles) in upper property area (Reiley Mtn) where ATV activity has been seen in the past. **Commission Hike \_Sunday Nov 1 at 1pm** to flag Japanese Barberry bushes for removal next spring (2021).

Also, Frank needs to contact Student Conservation Association (SCA) regarding trail building around pond & possible loop trail up Reilly Mtn. Plan for early coordination with SCA for next year (2021) following resolution of corona virus.

- b. **Meadow Marsh Trail** Peter hiked this month and did some trail maintenance. He cut and removed several trees that came down in recent wind storms. **Potential hike and added maintenance scheduled for November 8, time to be determined (tbd).**
- c. Lily Pond Trail Peter hiked this month and did some minor trail maintenance (hand clipping and brush pickup). Potential hike scheduled potentially for November 8, tbd after Meadow Marsh Trail.
- d. **Hurlin Property** has some substantial trees that need cutting and brush needs mowing. Schedule in Fall and winter 2020-2021. **Hike tbd potentially Nov 21 time tbd.**
- e. **Meetinghouse Hill Trail** to the Meetinghouse Hill Cemetery needs to be re-established. Peter has contacted Andrew Robblee re: new trail easement agreement. It is still in the negotiation stage. Will revisit after pandemic is resolved.
- f. Buttercup Lane Project underway with lead taken by Parks and Rec Department. Linda attended a field visit and the committee searched and found the survey pins identified in file survey plan. Peter is to meet with Isaac Lombard (Parks & Rec Chair) to work out a plan of action.
- g. Also, need to develop an integrated trail management plan for town and Master Plan. This is to be revisited after the pandemic is resolved.
