 - 6. Trails:
 - a. **Campbell Pond** Jeremy DeLisle placed additional signs prohibiting motorized vehicles (OHRV-Off Highway Recreational Vehicles) in upper property area (Reily Mtn) where ATV activity has been seen. He indicated that there was sign of recent activity. Jeremy & Peter are to hike up Reily Mountain soon to investigate further.

Also, Frank to again contact Student Conservation Association (SCA) regarding potential trail building around pond & possible loop trail up Reily Mtn. for summer of 2021.

- b. **Meadow Marsh Trail** Peter hiked Meadow Marsh Trail several times in the last two months and did some trail maintenance. He removed several trees that came down in recent windstorms.
- c. Lily Pond Trail Peter hiked in November and did some minor trail maintenance (hand clipping and brush pickup). Potential hike scheduled potentially after Hurlin Property review.
- d. Hurlin Property has some substantial trees that need cutting and brush needs mowing. Schedule in winter 2020-2021. Hike: Sunday, January 3 at noon to review and plan potential work needs.
